Treasurer's Report November 2018

As of 12/11/2018 there is a balance of \$12,373.88 in the operating account and \$12,495.35 in the restricted funds account. All bills in my possession have been paid to date. There are no outstanding payments due to the best of my knowledge.

Net income is showing a balance of \$3483.70. The budgeted total was for \$-1240.63, November 2017 was - \$5134.85. I have included a copy of the profit & loss for November and balance sheet for your review. The budgeted YTD profit (January 2018 to November 2018) was -\$24,816.99. The actual YTD is \$766.97.

As I have been reporting, the slow strengthening of our financial position is a clear sign of the efforts of the entire congregation. Many people are contributing through time, talent, treasure or some combination of the three. Everyone is doing a great job of making sure that Zion UCC will be here for a long time to come.
