# Zion UCC Consistory Meeting Minutes 11.14.2023

Approval Of Consistory Meeting Minutes - motioned for approval by Dave and seconded by Pierre. All attending members approved.

## Treasurer's Report

1. As of 11/4/2023 there is a balance of \$43,196.96 in the operating account and \$17,474.32 in the restricted funds account.

2. The revenue for October was \$12,811.59. The net income was \$806.00. In comparison: The revenue for October 2022 was \$25,812.66. The net income for October 2022 was \$13,449.71. YTD revenue for 2023 is \$152,358.77. YTD income for 2023 is \$-4172.26. In comparison the YTD revenue for 2022 was \$153,785.44 and the net income was \$7,056.66.

3. Ron thinks it is important that we are planning on how we are going to address the added expense of the insurance premiums we are taking over from the Trustees. This is a significant amount of revenue and will cause a serious drain on the bank account balance if we do not address this expense beyond the first year. Other large unplanned expenses will occur in a building as old as ours. A perfect example is the current work being done on the heating system. The final bill is sure to fall under the category of significant unplanned expense.
