

Dear Church,

The parking lot Construction at Zion has begun! We are very fortunate that it is beginning soon, however, it will unfortunately take longer than expected (they're saying 8 weeks total).

We hope and pray that everyone will still **join us for worship during the construction period**. Thankfully, we have ample parking available near the church to help make this possible.

Below are some of helpful tips for parking during the construction period:

- -We will have cones reserving parking for handicap accessibility in front of the Sanctuary. Please only use these designated spots for handicap parking.
- -We will also have an area marked for "drop off only" so those who would like to drop someone off in front of the sanctuary and park elsewhere.
- -We encourage street parking on Koenig, Woodstock Ave., Lynbrook Ave., and Fries Rd.. Please safely cross the street as you walk to church.
- -We will send out an email every Friday with updates on the parking lot so that you can anticipate where to park that Sunday.
- -All of the doors to the church will be opened during worship. This means you might prefer to enter through the Narthex or Kuck Hall instead of the parking lot entrance.
- -No activities or worship services will be cancelled during this time. So make sure to join us!
- -We anticipate people will be late to worship as we navigate this temporary parking, so please do not worry about walking into church late. We would rather have you here late than not with us each week!

We know that this is going to be a tricky period, but we hope and pray that everyone will try their hardest to worship with us in person or online during construction. We also ask that everyone **continue to give as they're able**, since we know attendance might decline during construction.


Celebrating the Life of Donna Maunz



Joint Meeting with Trustees

• There was a joint brainstorming meeting with the Trustees tonight with the primary discussion being about growth and vision for our church moving forward. Note: More discussion about ideas will be done during our regular meeting next month.

Treasurer's Report (Ron Janiszewski)

- As of 4/1/2024 there is a balance of \$44,373.65 in the operating account and \$18,800.55 in the restricted funds account. The operating account balance takes into consideration the payroll for 4/5/24.
- The revenue for March was \$17,655.18. The net income was \$-2984.00. In comparison: The revenue for March 2023 was \$22,177.14. The net income for March 2023 was \$6,003.29. YTD revenue for 2024 is \$55,200.65. YTD net income for 2024 is \$1,953.78. In comparison the YTD revenue for 2023 was \$55,210.54 and the net income was \$6,556.36.
