Pastor's Letter:

Hello Church,

Lately, the 23rd Psalm is on my mind. "The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside the still waters, he restores my soul..."

I love the 23rd Psalm. I recite it when people are in the hospital, I recite it as people prepare to go home to the Lord, and sometimes I recite it in the car, as a sort of meditation.

I have noticed that reciting the 23rd Psalm can slow down a person's anxious breathing. And I feel my own anxiety decrease as I recite it. Those words, written by King David 3,000 years ago, are powerful.

And those words come to mind as summer approaches: the green pastures, the still waters, our souls restored.

We have a lot going on this summer, and there's always hustle and bustle, but will you also take some time to breathe, to enjoy the beauty of God's creation, and to feel God's presence?

If you haven't already, maybe memorize the 23rd Psalm. And as you find yourself outside in nature, recite those words. And as you find yourself anxious or upset, recite those words again. Feel peace enter into your soul as you recite this poetic psalm.

Let's begin reciting them today:

The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures, He leads me beside the still waters, He restores my soul.

He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake.

Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil.

You are with me.

Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies.

You anoint my head with oil.

My cup overflows.

Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.
